International collaborative research and educational exchanges with the University of Wisconsin-Madison

On May 9 Professor Jiwan Palta of the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in the U.S. visited OUAVM to discuss international collaborative research and educational exchanges through practical training and lectures for students.

Professor Palta has long studied plant physiology and has achieved great achievements in quality improvement through calcium fertilization in potato cultivation.

On this visit, he discussed international collaborative research in the agricultural and livestock field with Professors Masayuki Tani, and Hiroshi Koaze, plus other professors in the Research Center for Global Agromedicine. He also gave a short lecture on May 12 on the importance of calcium in potato cultivation as part of the Environmentally Sound Agriculture and Livestock Science Training Course for second-year undergraduate students.
