JICA Group Training Program on the Farmer-led Extension Method (A) completed

The closing ceremony of the group training program on the Farmer-led Extension Method (A) was held at the main conference room of the administration building at OUAVM on June 9.

The Hokkaido International Center (Obihiro) of the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) commissioned OUAVM to provide this training program. Lectures and practical training are provided twice a year, in spring and autumn, with the help of related organizations in Japan to foster extension workers who can create and implement curricula for farmer-led agricultural education in their home countries.

The spring program was conducted from May 11 to June 9 under the guidance of program leader Professor Mutsuyo Kadohira of the Farm Animal Disease Control Section, Field Center of Animal Science and Agriculture, OUAVM. At the closing ceremony, a total of 13 trainees from eight countries, including Burkina Faso, Cambodia and Tajikistan, received completion certificates and celebrated completing the one-month training.
