Japan and Denmark Strategic Partnership Seminar at OUAVM

The Japan and Denmark Strategic Partnership Seminar, led by the Danish Embassy, was held at the main lecture hall at OUAVM on October 4. It was attended by 222 people.

This seminar, “Shift Toward Employment-based Dairy Management and Educational Support Learned from Denmark”, was cosponsored by OUAVM, Hokuren (Federation of Agricultural Cooperatives), Tokachi Nokyoren (Federation of Tokachi Agricultural Cooperatives), Yotsuba Milk Products Co., Ltd. and Meiji Co., Ltd. It highlighted examples in Denmark of stable dairy management and educational support for securing employment as dairy farmers to promote sustainable, safe and efficient food and crop production.

The opening address was delivered by Lene Mølsted Jensen, a minister counsellor from the Danish Embassy (in charge of food and agriculture). Then, Kiyoshi Okuda, the president of OUAVM, gave a speech in which he said he hoped to learn a lot from the management models of large dairy farming corporations in Denmark. During the seminar, a consultant from SEGED (a dairy and agricultural knowledge center in Denmark) talked about data management for corporate dairy farming. Also, an official in charge of Asia at Dalumn Agricultural College in Denmark introduced the educational system and human resource development methods for dairy farming successors in Denmark.
