**My Little Guidebook (winter version) released on a video sharing site**

My Little Guidebook is a short sightseeing PR film created by local volunteers who wanted to share the appeal of Tokachi to potential overseas visitors. The summer version was released in spring last year. In this winter version, a sequel to the summer version, young Taiwanese actress Wu Shinti plays the leading role as a travel writer (the same as in the summer version) who revisits Tokachi and discovers even more of the charms that it has to offer through interacting with locals.
