**Presentations by the returning short-term student volunteers**

Presentations by the seventh group of short-term student volunteers were done on December 6. They were in Paraguay from August 18 to September 23 taking part in the Obihiro-JICA Volunteer Team Partnership Program. The four returning students reported on the results and issues of the program based on the surveys of milking hygiene, reproduction management, feeding and farm management that they conducted with the help of the long-term volunteers working in Itapúa Department in southern Paraguay.

After that, students who are going to work in the country from late February 2017 as the eighth group of short-term volunteers made presentations on the results of their studies regarding the history, culture, Japanese community, and agriculture of Paraguay.

This Obihiro-JICA Volunteer Team Partnership Program was scheduled to end in March 2018, but a decision has been made to extend it until March 2024 thanks to the efforts and activities of previous participants .
