

# 2019 Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) provides scholarships for privately financed international students to help them with their academic work and research in Japan.

## 1. Qualifications

- (1) As of April 1 2019, the student must be enrolled as a regular-student in undergraduate/graduate school.
- (2) The student must have the status of residence "Student".

## 2. Duration of Scholarship and Monthly Stipend

- (1) Duration of Scholarship  
One year (April 2019 ~ March 2020)
- (2) Monthly stipend  
Undergraduate, Graduate: 48,000 yen

## 3. Requirements

Applicants must have an excellent academic achievement as an undergraduate/graduate-level student and meet the following requirements:

- (1) **The scholastic evaluation score of previous year** is required more than 2.30. The applicant must keep the same or better level of scholastic evaluation during the scholarship period.

[How to calculate the scholastic evaluation score]

$$\frac{(\text{Number of 秀(S)and 優(A) Credit} \times 3) + (\text{Number of 良(B)Credit} \times 2) + (\text{Number of 可(C)Credit} \times 1) + (\text{Number of 不可(F)Credit} \times 0)}{\text{Total Number of Credit}}$$

\* Miscalculation of scholastic evaluation may be considered as the subject of point- deduction.

\* Please refer to the evaluation sheet of academic record for the calculation.

- (2) Applicants who can be cooperative with JASSO's research regarding which course scholars take after graduation.
- (3) The allowance sent from the student's private funding source may not exceed, on average, 90,000 yen per month (excluding enrollment fee and tuition fee).
- (4) The annual income earned by supporter(s) who is/are resident in Japan may not exceed 5,000,000yen.
- (5) Those who is not receiving any scholarships from other organization that restrict multiple scholarships.
- (6) The student does not receive the scholarship of Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-term study in Japan) by JASSO.
- (7) Applicants must meet the condition, that necessary required condition of Japanese or English languages by meeting one of the following conditions:

### 【Japanese】

- Achieved a Japanese language proficiency test score equivalent to the N2 JLPT level or above.
- Achieved a score of 200 points or above in the subject of Japanese on the EJU.
- Completion of courses of study where the language of instruction is Japanese.

**【English】**

- Achieved an English language proficiency test score equivalent to the B2 CEFR(Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) level or above. [E.g.TOEFL iBT 72 or above, IELTS 5.5 or above, TOEIC L&R 785 or above and etc.]
- Completion of courses of study where the language instruction is English.

4. Documents to be submitted

- (1) Application form
- (2) Academic transcript of the previous year
- (3) Scholastic evaluation score
- (4) Certificate of language proficiency (in Japanese or English)
- (5) Copy of passport
- (6) Copy of resident card (both side)
- (7) Copy of japan Post Office's bank book

Documents will be accepted in the International Student Office.

6. Due Date

By 17:00 on April 15 (Mon.), 2019
