Request to refrain from entering the OUAVM campus in accordance with
the State of Emergency Measures in Hokkaido

Following the Japanese government's declaration of a nationwide state of emergency in response to COVID-19 and Hokkaido being designated as a "special alert prefecture," the Governor of Hokkaido has requested that all residents stay home except for essential outings and that facilities (universities, etc.) halt operations based on the State of Emergency Measures in Hokkaido (April 20; revised edition).

Obihiro University of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine has set the Six Rules to Fight Against Infectious Diseases and the Individual Response to Infectious Diseases as well as worked to ensure that all members of our university community are fully aware of them. However, we take this request from the Governor of Hokkaido to prevent the spread of infection very seriously and have decided to take further measures against COVID-19.

We, therefore, ask that you refrain from entering the OUAVM campus for non-essential reasons during the period listed below.

Please continue to take care and stay well. Your understanding and cooperation regarding this most recent measure are appreciated.
