

**JASSO [Gakushu-Shoreihi] Honors Scholarship for  
Privately Financed International Students 2021  
Additional Adoption (6 months)**

Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) provides scholarships for privately financed international students to help them with their academic work and research in Japan. OUAVM is able to recommend 2 international students to JASSO.

1. Duration of Scholarship and Monthly Stipend

From October 2021 to March 2022 (6 month), 48,000 yen

2. Qualifications

Those who demonstrate excellent academic achievement and personality, who have difficulty studying due to financial reasons, and who meet the following conditions (1) to (8).

- (1) Applicant must have the minimum of 2.30 GPA, which is calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method, based on a transcript from the previous academic year. If the applicant's transcript of the previous academic year is not available, GPA will be calculated based on his/her transcript of the previous semester. In case converting grades using JASSO's calculation method is impossible, we will measure the applicant's academic excellence from their transcript and other materials.  
To calculate the GPA using JASSO's calculation method, please refer to the "JASSO's GPA Calculation Sheet" in the application form.
- (2) Applicant must have Japanese or English abilities that meet either i) or ii).
  - i) Japanese Language Qualification
    - Applicant who passed the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) with a score of N2 or higher.
    - Applicant who completed an educational program whose primary language of instruction is Japanese.
  - ii) English Language Qualification
    - Applicant who holds an English proficiency test score equivalent to B2 or above on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) scale (e.g. TOEFL iBT 72 or above, IELTS 5.5 or above, TOEIC L&R:785 or higher).
    - Applicant who completed at least 3 years of education in upper secondary education with English as their first language.
    - Applicant who obtained a degree with English as their first language.
- (3) Applicants who can be cooperative with JASSO's research regarding which course scholars take after graduation.
- (4) The allowance sent from the student's private funding source may not exceed, on average, 90,000 yen per month (excluding enrollment fee and tuition fee).
- (5) The annual income earned by supporter(s) who is/are resident in Japan may not exceed 5,000,000yen.
- (6) Those who are not receiving any a scholarship that cannot be combined with other scholarship.
- (7) The student does not receive the scholarship of Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-term study in Japan) by JASSO.
- (8) As of October 1st 2021, the student must have the residence status of "Student", and stay in Japan with the same residence status as of October 1 2021.

- (2) JASSO's GPA Calculation Sheet
- (3) Academic transcript of the previous year
- (4) Copy of Japan Post BANK (Yucho) bank book
- (5) Certificate or document to prove your Language Proficiency

### 6. Notes

- OUAVM will screen the candidates and officially nominate to JASSO at the beginning of Oct 2021. OUAVM will notify the screening result by sending an email.
- The candidate nominated from OUAVM must come to the international student office to sign for the enrollment confirmation for October.
- The first installment is scheduled on November 16<sup>th</sup> 2021.
